Following a meeting with local residents, the proposed plans for a new Library are being looked at again by planners and architects.

Community Police Support Officers

Recent weeks have seen the deployment of two Community Police Support Officers in Wilmslow with responsibility for patrolling the town centre and surrounding roads. Already they have issued a number of tickets to motorists parked illegally. They will continue to do this.

They will also help the regular police in dealing with anti social behaviour problems.

Richard Duncalf said *"I am pleased we have this additional resource in the town which will do a lot to deal with the parking and nuisance problems we experience"*.

Council Tax 07/08 - The Untold Story!

At a recent meeting, Conservative controlled Macclesfield Borough Council set an increase in this year's Council Tax of 2.4%.

What local Conservative Councillors are failing to mention is that in order to balance the books, they have had to make dramatic cuts to services such as Anti Social Behaviour Measures (cut by 30%), Promotion of Healthy Living (cut by 30%), Road Repairs (cut by 15%) and Holiday Play Schemes (cut by 14%).

Richard Duncalf commented, *'no-one is in favour of inflation busting rises in Council Tax, but these cuts really underline the fact that Macclesfield BC does not care about local people.'*

PAT TAKES ACTION TO HELP THE ENVIRONMENT.

Your local Liberal Democrat County Councillor, Pat Fearnley, has taken action to cut her carbon footprint. She has recently had solar panels installed which help heat her water. If you would like to know more about this, ring her on 524700.
